Sharing the 2022 RMHC Manitoba Mission



Thanks to incredibly generous support, the new Ronald McDonald House provides more families with essential services 24/7/365 days a year as they face the challenges of childhood illness or injury together.

The project is a 186% increase in mission delivery, growing from 11,000 sq. ft. to 48,000 sq. ft. and from 14 to 40 bedrooms,

each with a private washroom. The House includes two kitchens to support meal programs, multipurpose rooms, specialty suites to serve bone marrow and organ transplant patients, secure parking, as well as indoor and outdoor play areas. ...Continued on next page

The new Ronald McDonald House is RMHC Manitoba's next legacy of support and service to family-centered care in Manitoba and Northwestern Ontario.

65% of Canadians live outside a city with a children's hospital, which means they must travel to receive the care their children need. RMHC Manitoba's previous capacity and design was limited, and the House turned away hundreds of families each year due to operating at or above occupancy. The new RMHC Manitoba Ronald McDonald House significantly increases support for families with sick or injured children.


Keeping the Kanhai Family Together

"I began to know about RMHC in my teens, but I really began to know more about RMHC once I started working at McDonald's at the age of 15. I saw RMHC signage and I knew people would put their change into donation boxes for RMHC, but I didn't really know how much it impacted people. I worked my way up to being a Department Manager and really began focusing on raising more funds for McHappy Day. We would have times where we encouraged guests to donate to McHappy Day daily. It felt good coming together as a restaurant and as a company to raise money for families who were going through this journey with a sick child. Little did I know, I would be one of the families benefitting from RMHC programs.

We stayed at the Ronald McDonald Family Room for three nights and at Ronald McDonald House for a week while our daughter, Khalia, received treatment for GBS (group B strep).

She was improving every day and became stronger and more lively. We went from not being able to hear our daughter's voice to being able to breastfeed her again and take her home. She got to go home after 12 days of being at the hospital. We are so thankful for all the staff at the hospital who took such good care of our daughter. We are also very thankful for RMHC Manitoba. It made this very hard situation bearable and feel a little more normal. The staff were all so kind, and we even made connections with another family in the house.

After Khalia became strong enough, we were so excited to be able to take her home and get back to normal life again. She caught a little cold in the few days after, but it only lasted a week. She recovered so well and hasn't looked back. We couldn't be more proud of our little warrior and are so thankful for everyone that helped her get to where she is today." lacksquare — The Kanhai family
